In addition to virtual events, in-person Carousel Family Days will be held at the park each month throughout the summer with social distancing and other guidelines in place to prioritize the health and safety of visitors and staff. Also, on May 1 the carousel will open to the public for the first time since closing for repairs in July 2019. It will operate with limited capacity due to Covid-19 safety protocols.
