Covid-19 Update on Park Facilities & Programs May 28, 2021

As Montgomery County moves into the final phase of re-opening, with most restrictions lifted, we would like to provide an update on the status of the Park and our facilities. Below you will find information about park buildings and grounds, resident studios, the Partnership office, and more. For information on classes, visit glenechopark.org/classes.

Additional updates will be provided as more on-site programs are resumed. In the meantime, we hope you and your family are enjoying spring, remaining healthy, and staying creative through our many in-person and virtual offerings!

Masks are no longer required when outdoors at the Park, per Montgomery County guidelines. However, we are still requiring masks indoors, including in our galleries. Capacity restrictions in the galleries are now lifted.

Carousel: The carousel is open to the public and operating with limited capacity until further notice. Masks are still required. To purchase tickets and view operating hours, visit glenechopark.org/carousel.

Partnership Office: Closed to the public. Staff available by phone (301-634-2255) or email (info@glenechopark.org). The office will resume some in-person hours over the summer. More information will be provided at a later date.

Resident Artist Studios and Galleries: Hours and availability vary. Please check with each artist studio or organization. Many studios are still closed to the public or open on a very limited basis.
