To make summer camp fun, safe, and enjoyable for all campers, we have one simple rule:

**Be kind to each other.**

### WHAT THAT MEANS

- **Respectful:** Treat others how you want to be treated. Use kind words and actions.
- **Open-minded:** Give new things a try and familiar things a new approach. Listen & learn.
- **Creative:** Discover, share, and collaborate with other campers.
- **Kind:** Include others, invite them to join, and build new friendships.
- **Safe:** Speak Up! If you see or experience someone being unkind or unsafe, tell a camp counselor right away—they're here to help.

### WHAT'S NOT ALLOWED

- **Bullying, Name-Calling or Teasing:** Saying mean things about someone or making fun of others is not okay.
- **Exclusion:** Purposely leaving someone out is hurtful.
- **Hitting or Pushing:** Physical harm is never allowed. Keep your hands to yourself or on your art!

### IF THERE'S A PROBLEM

1. **Talk It Out:** First try to solve problems by talking, listening and understanding each other.
2. **Take a Break:** If needed, a short break can calm things down.
3. **Get a Parent/Guardian Involved:** If things don't get better, we'll talk to parents immediately to find the best way to help solve the problem.
4. **In Extreme Cases:** If there is bullying, fighting or other disruptive behavior, we will notify a Parent/Guardian that the camper may not attend the remainder of the camp session.
