## **50<sup>th</sup> Annual Labor Day Art Show Postponed Due to Covid-19**

The Partnership has postponed the Labor Day Art Show, an annual Glen Echo Park tradition that would have celebrated its 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary over Labor Day Weekend.

Held in the historic Spanish Ballroom for the past 49 years, the show typically features over 250 artists and more than 600 works in a wide range of media, including sculpture, painting and drawing, ceramics, glass, jewelry, photography, textiles, furniture, and works on paper. The exhibition has always been free and open to the public and included a public reception as well as a special preview for Glen Echo Park Partnership members.

Much thought was given to how we might be able to mount the Labor Day Art Show in the current environment, but in the end we made the difficult decision to postpone the show in order to ensure the safety of the artists, patrons, volunteers and staff. We look forward to celebrating the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Labor Day Art Show in 2021.
